Missions Around the World

There are more than 7,000 promises in the Bible from God to you. They're like blank checks just waiting on you to cash. And with every promise, there's a premise.

In the Bible's most famous promise, John 3:16, Jesus tells us, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (NKJV). God promises we won't perish if we believe in him.

God's free gift of salvation is offered to everyone. It doesn't matter your religion or cultural background. Jesus Christ died for you.

How do we receive this free gift?

The Bible says, "God says he will accept and acquit us — declare us 'not guilty' — if we trust Jesus Christ to take away our sins. And we all can be saved in this same way, by coming to Christ, no matter who we are or what we have been like" (Romans 3:22 TLB).

Though anyone can acknowledge the existence of Jesus, the only way we can get to heaven is by placing our trust in him. You can't trust Jesus unless you really know him.

It's the difference between your head and your heart. It's the heart that counts and what God looks at. If we truly love Christ, we will love others. We may go through conflict but we will still love those we are in conflict with. (I believe I just heard that in a sermon!) If we truly love Christ, we.will.love.others. Not on our own accord but with the help of the Holy Spirit.

I challenge you to get out of your comfort zone. Invite someone to church that you know but doesn't attend. Plan to go on a mission trip...maybe to Atlanta, Georgia to work with Daniel & Sarah Zagami in 2019! Do we get excited to tell others about Christ or do we shy away from talking about Jesus? Do we get excited when someone gives their life to Christ and gets baptized? If not, we need to let God have control over our life instead of us trying to control it. We don't have to go on a mission trip to be a missionary for God. We are all missionaries right here in our own little town!

Ronda will be ordering and then bring them to Lyn's home for our local USFW library. Lyn and Regina had already distributed the 2017-2018 books to our church library.
