## **USFW Church Rummage Sale September 23rd**

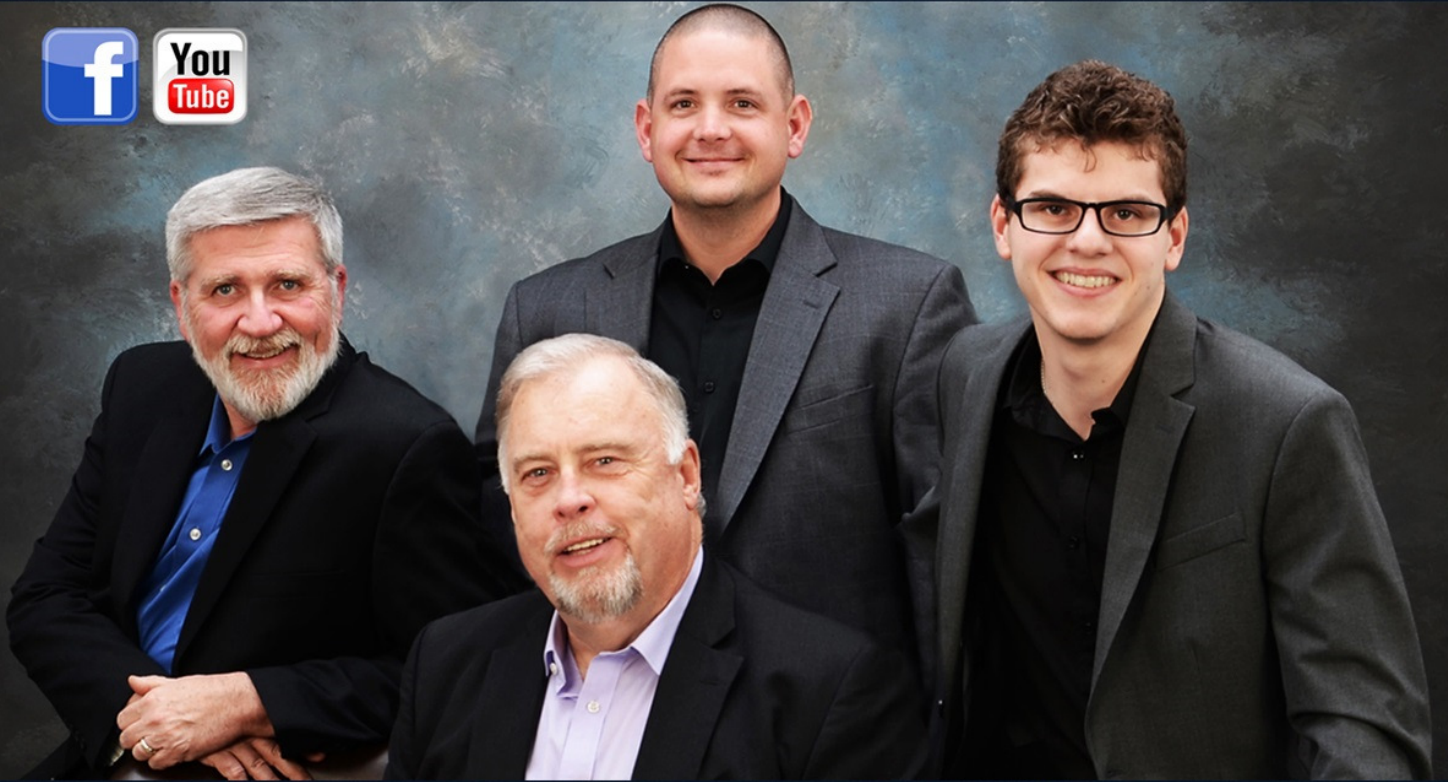
